Please put the following dates on your schedule for August:

5th Grade Transition & Laptop Roll-out: August 15 at 7:00 PM in the Commons with Mrs. Schutjer

9th Grade Transition & Laptop Roll-out: August 15 at 6:00 PM in the Auditorium with Mrs. Bergeson

- **A parent/guardian is required to attend these meetings with their child.** We will do a handbook overview and other important information for 5th & 9th grade students.

Elementary Back to School Conferences on August 22 and 23, 2017:

- K-Prep – 4th Grade will have scheduled conferences. Students should plan to come with their parents and bring supplies along at the scheduled time.
- The first day of school for elementary will be on August 24.

Middle School Back to School Conferences on August 22 and 23, 2017:

- 6th, 7th, 8th grade students will receive their laptops at Back to School conferences. **Students will need to bring in their signed technology forms and insurance payment.** Forms will be available at Walk-in Registration or will be available at Back to School conferences. All outstanding fees must be fully paid in order to take a computer home. If outstanding fees are not paid, students will need to check computers in at the end of each school day and will not be allowed to take them home until a family's account is up to date.
- 5th grade students will already have their laptops but will still attend Back to School conferences.
- The first day of school for Middle School students will be on August 24.

High School Computer Rollout on August 23, 2017:

- 10th through 12th grade students will get their laptops on the first day of school, which is scheduled for August 23. **Students will need to bring in their signed technology forms and insurance payments on or before August 23. Students who do not have their technology forms will not be issued a computer on the first day of school.** All outstanding fees must be fully paid in order to take a computer home. If outstanding fees are not paid, students will need to check computers in at the end of each school day and will not be allowed to take them home until a family's account is up to date.
- 10th through 12th grade students will have a handbook overview meeting followed by their computer checkout on the first day of school.
- All 9th through 12th grade students will report to the auditorium on the first day of school at 8:25 AM for general announcements.
